Students have been using Nearpod to enhance the creativity, collaboration and presentation of their learning. 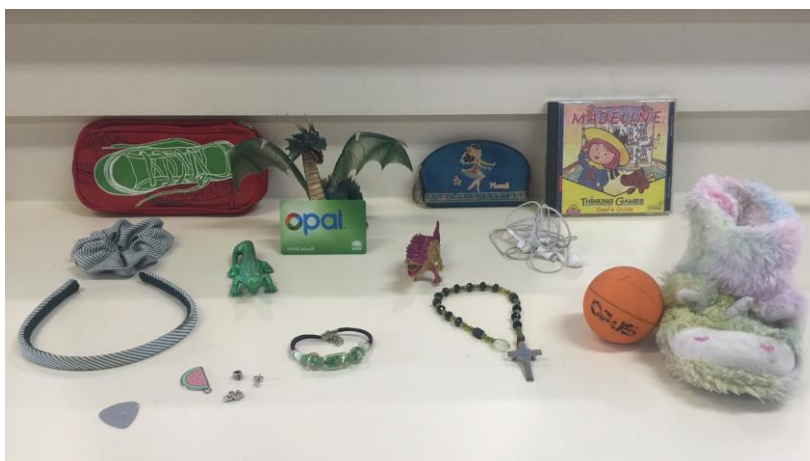
UNIFORMS and LOST PROPERTY
