ICAS 2019

Sacred Heart Mona Vale will be participating once again in the International Competitions and Assessment for Schools (ICAS). Students in **Years 3 to 6** have been invited to participate in the **2019 International Competitions and Assessment for Schools (ICAS)** in English, Mathematics, Digital Technologies, Science, Writing and Spelling.

Students in **Year 2** have been invited to participate in English, Mathematics, Science and Spelling.

The competition is an initiative of Educational Assessment Australia (EAA) of the University of New South Wales. It should be noted that these are **NOT TESTS**. These are competitions and are not necessarily based on the stage outcomes the children are working on, as often, they are set at the stage above. All students receive a Certificate and an individual Student Report indicating which questions they answered correctly, as well as the average mark for their state.

These competitions /assessments are not compulsory. Competitions are held at school on the following days:

Wellbeing



Wellbeing Team Meeting

At Sacred Heart there is a dedicated group of Teachers and Parents who meet twice a term to discuss Wellbeing. This year’s team is made up of 6 staff, 2 parents and 1 teacher from 3-6S and a teacher from St Mary’s Manly. The team follows a particular format of celebrating successes, reviewing the school Long Time Out Data, discussion of Wellbeing Week, the role of the SRC and any other items that relate to student wellbeing.

The Wellbeing Team met last week and identified that the students have settled well into school for 2019. The celebration of success mentioned that the playground environment created opportunities for students to mix across year groups and classes. That the air-conditioning had impacted on the children’s behaviour as the classroom environments were cool and children were able to transition from the playground to the classroom.

The Importance of Breakfast and Fruit Break/ Crunch & Sip

Did you know that if your child has a good breakfast it will help their concentration and allow them to have a longer attention span? They will be able to learn better and be in a better mood.

That is why at Sacred Heart we also have Fruit Break/ Crunch & Sip. This happens every day in the morning block usually around 10 o’clock. The reason for this is to give your child the opportunity to ‘refuel’ on vegetables and fruit as well as ‘rehydrate’ on water. This time is for students to continue working whilst snacking on their fruit or vegetable. Many class teachers read to their students whilst they are eating. Studies have shown that by creating this opportunity it increases concentration and student’s fruit and vegetable consumption. *So remember to pack your child or have your child pack a healthy snack of fruit/ vegetable and water.*
