Dear Parents

Congratulations to Fr Bronek and to Fr Richard who celebrate milestones in their priesthood ministry. Fr Bronek has been ordained a priest for 30 years and Fr Richard has been ordained 20 years. Tonight our school and parish communities come together to celebrate their contribution to our faith community.

Our first "Learning Together" Playgroup commences tomorrow, Thursday 30 May. We are looking forward to welcoming the pre-schoolers and young children from our surrounding community to Sacred Heart. These families may be considering Sacred Heart for primary school or not. All are welcome. The playgroup will be held in the hall and is open to any family and any child under school age to attend, mums, dads, grandparents and carers welcome.

From time to time a more serious incident on the playground may result in a child needing significant First Aid. It is pleasing to note that our staff are well trained in First Aid, CPR, asthma and anaphylaxis management. There are crisis management plans and emergency procedures that are regularly updated as well as individual health management plans for some students. Our First Aid room is also stocked with a defibrillator.

Year 5 and Year 6 are excited to be participating in an overnight excursion to Canberra next week. This excursion compliments their History study of our nation. Mrs Ngamu, Mrs McBryde, Mrs Nolan-Brown, Mrs Wood and Miss Perry will be accompanying the students. Parents are asked to review the expectations of behaviour that will be sent home for signing. Any student who is unable to display appropriate behaviour to meet the expectations will be asked to leave the excursion.

Sacred Heart hosted the Northern Beaches Maths Challenge on Monday. Year 6 students from Maria Regina, Avalon, St Rose Collaroy Plateau and St Joseph's Narrabeen were challenged to work collaboratively to problem solve questions and to develop higher order thinking. Building on each other's ideas and lateral thinking were a feature of the morning. For the next session students will visit Mater Maria, to work mathematically with the senior students.

- 4. Problem Solve-Instead of replacing straight away, have your child go to the Lost Property and look for their belongings.
