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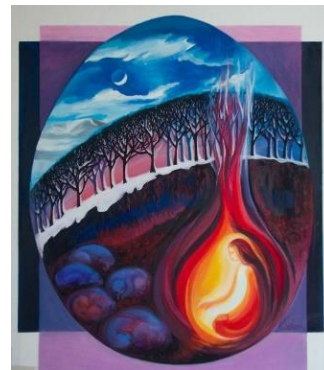

Semester 1 reports were emailed home today. The number of full days a student is absent is recorded on the reports and it is concerning that there are students with many days absent. If children are unwell, this is understandable, however many students have unexplained absences and regularly arrive late and depart early from school. If a student is absent 10 or more days in a semester this equates to 1 day a fortnight. This is considered habitual non attendance. Students who are frequently absent do not have the same learning opportunities as others and also often struggle to develop friendships.

Today in classrooms during Inspire and Innovate Kindergarten children used stop motion on the iPads to take photos and then create an animation. They chose sight words from the word wall and captured photos of magnetic letters to show their sight words 'moving' across a table or the floor. They enjoyed seeing their photos come to life today and with more practice they will improve their photography and animation skills. Some of our year 2 students used Pages to create information reports whilst Year 1 continued working with Picollage, Safari and Book Creator. Apple Classroom is set up in many of our classrooms and is fantastic for monitoring what our students are working on and making sure they are on task.

We wish Mrs Satchell our very best wishes as she commences maternity leave from this Friday. Mrs Neasmith will complete term 2 in year 1S and then Mrs Gikas will be fulltime in year 1 for the remainder of the year.
