Dear Parents

It is with sincere thanks we congratulate our outgoing HUB Co Presidents Grant Howard and Amanda Lewis. The goals for their time as Hub President of establishing a more contemporary parent body and air conditioners for the school were successfully achieved. Congratulations and thank you! The Hub AGM last Wednesday was exciting as we reimagined the Hub for 2020.

For 2020 each class/year group will be asked to co-ordinate one of our major events. 
