#### **Dear Parents**

A huge thank you for your wonderful support of our school during this turbulent time. I am incredibly proud of the way that our community has dealt with the home learning thrown upon us, the compliance with the necessary restrictions and adjustments that we have had to introduce and the continual positivity in conversations to support the well-being of each other. As we look back over the term we reflect on the very many blessings that we have here at Sacred Heart. We are an incredibly fortunate and resilient community who continues to thrive through the many challenges that we have had to face.

A reminder that Friday this week is a <u>staff development day</u> (SDD) as directed by the interim director of schools, Mr. Danny Casey, for all schools in the Diocese of Broken Bay. There will be no supervision of children on Friday. This day is to explore a new vision titled "Catholic Schools Towards 2025" and will set the strategic directions for all 44 Catholic schools in Broken Bay.

As we begin to plan for next term there is still some uncertainty as government restrictions for <u>Covid-19</u> are being lifted in some areas and reinforced in others. For our school we will continue to make the adjustments necessary to keep all safe. Therefore we will continue to:

- employ a hygienist to clean the school daily in addition to our normal cleaner
- open the canteen for reduced service lunches only (via online orders)
- stagger recess and lunch breaks to reduce the number of children on the playground
- have limited access for parents and to the playground.
- remind children of healthy hygiene practices
- encourage children to stay home if unwell
- limit whole school gatherings such as assembly and Masses.

Due to the high risk factor for the elderly at this stage <u>Grandparent's Day</u> will not be proceeding. In its place however we will be inviting grandparents to Zoom into their grandchild's class for a liturgy on Wednesday 29 July.

Children will be resuming attending a weekly Mass one class per week in Term 3.

We are hopeful that the scheduled <u>Annual Athletic's Carnival</u> may proceed in some form depending on the reopening of the Sydney Academy of Sport and Recreation, Narrabeen. We will need to comply with the Public Health Orders for gatherings, therefore this event may be without spectators.

<u>Staffing Update</u> for Term 3. We thank and farewell Mrs Osborn and welcome back Miss Ovens into year 4G. We are delighted that Mrs Neasmith in year 2G and Mrs Kerr, job share in year 5B, will continue for Term 3. Mrs Garey will be on long service leave (playing some golf), for the first two weeks of Term 3. Mrs Ngamu will be Acting Principal for Week 1 and Week 2 in Term 3.

Semester reports are completed and are available on COMPASS today.

Ian our <u>Pedestrian Crossing</u> supervisor has asked for a reminder to parents not to call children across the crossing from one side of the street to the other. Children are asked to wait for lan's direction to cross.

## Bishop's Art Prize

During this term students across Kindergarten to Year 6 have been preparing movies to participate in the annual Bishop's Religious Visual Arts Prize 2020 - Film competition.

The Bishop's Religious Art Prize is once again using the medium of Film to reflect on and respond to The Gospel of Matthew. Matthew's Gospel allows us to enter the world of Jesus, who is presented as a Jewish Religious teacher. It provides the opportunity to explore the Jewish traditions and teachings in which Jesus was formed.



Students have been learning about a piece of scripture and will present their understanding and thinking about the story as a film.

Judging will occur at each stage level at Sacred Heart, with one entry per grade being submitted for judging.

The winning film from each stage will be submitted to the Diocesan Mission Services Team for judging which will occur at the end of term 3.

with size and type. The office staff will arrange a selection (if available) for you to look at via the office. Collection is by arrangement only.




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
