Dear Parents

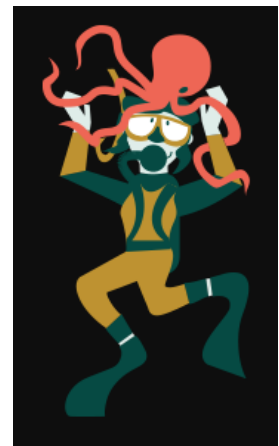
Welcome to Wellbeing Week at Sacred Heart. This week it was delightful to speak to the parents of students in Kindergarten and Year 1 on Zoom for the “Coffee and Conversation with the Principal”. These sessions were initiated to create the opportunity for parents to chat with Mrs Garey on any concerns they may have to share, the current restrictions for schools due to Covid and to connect with each other.
