Wellbeing @ Sacred Heart

This week the Wellbeing Team will be meeting to discuss and review our Wellbeing Initatives. The Wellbeing Team is made up of staff, parents and a PBL Coach from St Mary's Manly. The Wellbeing Team meets twice a term to celebrate, review and look at the PBL (Positive Behaviours for Learning) data.





This week will see children in our school be acknowledged for their demonstration of living the *Core Value of Justice for Self, Others and the Environment*. Each term a child from each class will receive this Core Value. This is a very important award as it teaches and reinforces the importance of Justice.

Electricity Safety Week

Last week was Electricity Safety Week. The main message was that Electricity is an important part of our life and we need to keep ourselves safe. This could be outside when playing near electrical poles, towers and powerlines. Whilst also inside the home when using electrical household appliances such as a toaster, hair dryer and hair straightener. The children were taught to stay 8 metres away from fallen powerlines and to tell an adult and call triple zero (000).

The four key safety messages were:

- Be careful when you play around poles and wires
- If you see a dangerous situation, tell an adult
- Know what to do in an electrical emergency
- Be Safe








SRC & Eco Leaders- Fruit and Vegetable Month


ENROLLING NOW for YEAR 7 2023
