POSITIVE Behaviours for Learning

At Sacred Heart we are always working at Growing the Green through Positive Behaviours for Learning. Growing the Green refers to the PBL Tier 1 Behaviour Management Systems that we have in place.

What are the Tier 1 Management Universals?

The Tier 1 Universals are the Core Values and Expectations, Reteaching, Redirecting and Responding to behaviour areas, Procedures and Routines, Classroom Environments, Active Supervision by staff and Student Voice.

The emphasis on having Positive Behaviours for Learning happens in all areas of school life. At Sacred Heart the physical environment is organised so that there is a variety of choice and different learning and playing spaces that are well organised and cater for different student's needs. One example of how this is achieved at Sacred Heart is through the variety of playground experiences and student voice in learning tasks provided from Kindergarten to Year 6.

Positive Behaviours for Learning occur through all our initiatives to create Wellbeing and Belonging. This is more than evident this week when you walked around the school to see our new Kindergartens for 2021 having their orientation day



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and our Year 6's participating in Cricket Skills Clinics. All the staff are explicitly teaching the behaviours and expectations that are needed for a safe and supportive learning environment.

Did you know we survey children to see how they are feeling about school and their experiences in the classroom and playground? The children across K-6 are currently completing the 'School Life Survey' and the Year 4- 6 children are completing the 'Tell them from Me' survey.

Wellbeing Week- Week 6

This week is Wellbeing Week at Sacred Heart -Monday 16 to Friday 20 November. The theme for Wellbeing Week is 'Inclusivity'. Inclusivity is an important theme as it means that everyone in the community feels valued and respected. It means that we should celebrate everyone's culture, special talent and interests.

On Friday the 20 November children are invited to wear to school clothes that celebrate who they are such as their culture, special talents and interest. Your child may like to wear a sporting group uniform that they belong to or colours that represent your family's culture.
