Year of the Family

As we celebrate the Year of the Family in our parish we can draw great wisdom from Pope Francis's Encyclical Amoris Laetitia ("The Joy of Love")

So what are some practical decisions that Francis offers to families to help love flourish within them? Here are a few highlights:

- Dialogue with each other: "This means being ready to listen patiently and attentively to everything the other person wants to say...Often the other spouse does not need a solution to his or her problems, but simply to be heard, to feel that someone has acknowledged their pain, their disappointment, their fear, their anger, their hopes and their dreams." [137]
- Develop a shared routine that incorporates intentional acts of love: "These could include a morning kiss, an evening blessing, waiting at the door to welcome each other home, taking trips together, and sharing

household chores." [226] These examples might seem ordinary or boring, but represent repeated decisions to commit oneself to another.


