Dear Parents

Welcome back - well nearly. Finally we are moving closer to a full return to school and some normality! At Sacred Heart we are preparing for the return of students to meet their academic and emotional needs after such a long period of home based learning. Resources are being deployed to address any learning issues or social emotional issues. The academic focus of this preparation we have called Learning Plus. One such resource is the employment of casual teachers to release class teachers so that they can analyse, plan, act and review each student in a continuous improvement cycle. Teachers will be checking in with each student, reviewing their work completed over the last term at home, analysing where they are at, planning from their point of need and enabling the teaching for the student to continue.

Teachers will also be preparing lessons on resilience and wellbeing, focussing on making and keeping friends as well as debriefing and discussing how students have managed through the HBL period and the pandemic.

- 25 October Year 2 and Year 6
- 1 November Year 3,4,5,

- it is recommended that students wear masks but they are not compulsory,
- all staff will wear masks
- parents will drop and collect children at Kiss and Ride or at the front gate
- staggered return year groups as per roadmap above
- vaccinations for staff as per Public Health Order
- strict personal hygiene and social distancing,
- canteen and library may open.
- school hygienist continues
- band continues online
- assembly will be through the PA system in the office
- school performances, gala days, excursions and P&F activities will not be permitted at this stage



Second Hand Uniform Shop


Our second hand Uniform Shop is, unfortunately, currently closed to parents to visit.
