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### From your School Crossing Supervisor



It is lovely to see all the children , Mums, Dads and Carers back at school, but as I have said to a number of parents, I need to run a retraining course.



I'm sure you know that my main function is to keep you all safe.

To do this after the resumption, can you help me with the following concerns.

**WAIT** I will always ask you to wait until I am sure that all cars have stopped or are slowing to stop. Please talk to your children, so they understand I will <u>always</u> ask them to wait. This is more important when they start to cross by themselves.

**LOOK FOR ME** I have had many instances in the last few days where I have had my hand up to stop people crossing and are signalling cars to come through and suddenly find a parent or Carer just walking onto the road, head down talking to a child. Please take ten seconds before you step out to see what I am signalling to either people or vehicles.

<u>CHILDREN RUNNING ACROSS THE CROSSING</u> This is an afternoon event and appears to be mainly by boys. Please talk to your children and ask them to walk across the crossing, not run.

### Student Pick-up and Drop - off

### PICK-UP:

We thought it timely again to remind parents and carers of the important kiss and ride rules the school has in place to ensure the free flow of traffic and safety of our students:



- Have your name sign ready (if you would like one, please email the office).
- <u>LEFT TURN only</u> from Waratah Street into Keenan Street please do not turn right from Waratah Street to join the queue. There is a roundabout in Waratah Street for you to do a U-turn and join the queue.
- Wait for your child to be called by the teacher on duty who will open your car door for your child to enter safely.
- Kiss and Ride instructions are provided to you when we provide your name sign.
- Please do not use the staff car park to pick-up/drop-off or do U-turns.

### **DROP-OFF:**

The morning drop-off can be hectic when dropping your child off at school. If you are dropping off your child by car via the kiss and ride area, please ensure your child has their school bag with them so you will not need to leave your car (unless they need assistance of course). Usually we have parent volunteers who facilitate the morning drop-off and we do hope to resume this programme in 2022.

A reminder that school starts at 8:45am. Covid restrictions have been relaxed, so if you running late, you are required to accompany your child into the school office and sign them in at the Compass kiosk. (The Compass Parent Portal is where parents enter whole day absences, and the Compass Kiosk at the school office is where parents enter late arrivals and early departures).

Your co-operation is much appreciated.
