Next Wednesday the Year 5 students have the opportunity to present a speech to the students at Sacred Heart before the students and teachers vote for the students leaders for 2022. The leadership positions requiring a speech are School Captain, Vice Captain and Colour House Captain. In preparation for their speeches, Year 5 participated in a "Leadership Day" today discussing the qualities of leaders and what strengths do the students have that can be shared with others whilst in a leadership position.

Class lists for 2022 are being prepared. The process involves the children selecting three friends to be with the following year. We assure the children they will be with at least one of these friends. The class teachers make recommendations about groups of students who work well together and those children for whom it would be better to be apart from. Classes need to have a mix of boys and girls and children who have diverse learning needs. It is quite a process for balancing the classes. We are fortunate to have two classes of students in each grade so that children have the opportunity of developing a range of friendships over the years. It is important to be able to know how to make new friends.

All students will meet their teacher for 2022 if possible on Tuesday 7 December.

The Awareness Examen

Did you know that Year 6 have been leading the Daily Awareness Examen in the classrooms each day after lunch? Four students from Year 6 attend a set class and take the children through the daily examen. The Awareness Examen comes from the St Ignatius Loyola tradition. It is a technique of prayerful reflection where the aim is to come closer to God. It is a tradition at Sacred Heart for our senior students to lead this prayerful examen.

The children are called to reflect upon and answer the questions in their minds – Thank God for something special you are aware of.

Go over the day in your mind- What was the best thing you heard?

What was the best thing you saw?

What was the best thing you did for someone else?

Is there anything you regret or feel sorry for?

Tell something to God about your day, as a friend would talk to a friend.

What can you do to improve tomorrow?

Conclude with a Hail Mary or Glory Be.

Year 5 and 6 Spirituality Day

On Wednesday it was the Year 5 and 6 Spirituality Day. The students in Year 5 were planning for the future as School Leaders and the Year 6 children were reflecting on and thinking about their transition to High School. Students watched and participated in a variety of workshops lead by our Stage 3 teachers. The students reflected on how the Holy Spirit is helping them with the next part of their life journey.

Religious Education Curriculum

Year 5 have been learning a Religious Education unit called Prayer: How can prayer enrich our lives? The students are exploring the Guiding Questions:

- How is communication the basis of building a relationship with others?
- How can we communicate with God through prayer?
- What are the different ways of praying and developing our relationship with God?
- What role does prayer play during Advent and in our preparation for Christmas?

The students have been exploring prayer using a prayer technique of responding to the Sacred Scripture by drawing a response. Included are some beautiful artworks produced by students in Year 5.


ALL Families at the school must complete the form.
