Advent is upon us.

It's possible that complacency can allow us to move through life comfortable with our quality of life and the fact that "we don't hurt anyone". We appear to be doing the right thing. But, when we look at Jesus whom we are preparing to welcome, are we as good as we think?

Religious Education

Advent

This Sunday it is the start of Advent. The word advent comes from the Latin adventus meaning coming: we wait and watch for the arrival of Christ. Advent is a time to reflect on how we are welcoming Jesus into our lives. We often hear the song O' Emmanuel meaning God is with us. Have you ever thought why do we use the word Emmanuel? It comes from the



God is with us. Have you ever thought why do we use the word Emmanuel? It comes from the Old Testament Book of Isaiah and then in Matthew's Gospel we then hear the word again with the word Jesus Christ.

On Friday the children will have a class liturgy to mark the Advent Season. Each class will have a purple cloth and candles to signify the advent wreath.

An Advent Wreath is a useful symbol of the season. The progressive lighting of the candles over the four weeks of Advent is a way to mark the passing of the time while we watch and wait for the advent of Christ at Christmas. This symbol comes from the Northern Hemisphere where Advent is celebrated during winter. In the dead of winter, the nights are long and the sun is too far away to give warmth to the earth. So it is appropriate to use candle light as a symbol of hope.

The use of light also reflects what Luke's gospel says about the advent of Christ: 'By the tender mercy of our God, the dawn from on high will break upon us, to give light to those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.' (Luke 1:78-79) (Brisbane Catholic Education 2010)

Why not bring Advent into your home and create your own Advent Candles?



Create your own Advent Candles

- 1. Purchase 4 white pillar candles or 3 purple and 1 pink
- 2. Cut out 3 Purple Ribbon's and write Hope, Love and Peace Then cut out one Pink Ribbon and write Joy
- 3. Glue around the Candles
- 4. To protect you can cut pieces of contact plastic and place around the whole candle.

Dear Parents,

Due to the international shipping delays of the like never seen before, stock deliveries are running 8 weeks minimum behind schedule and are expected to continue into next year. These delays are also affecting our local wholesalers with fabric availability, which is impacting our local manufacturing at Kingswood and in Fiji.

We would encourage all new students to purchase or order uniform if out of stock prior to the end of the year to ensure they are catered for prior to the new school year.

Appointments are required to maintain instore social distancing of 1 person per 2 square metres. We also ask that customers QR check in and provide proof of Vaccination certificate on entry to staff members as required under the Governments COVID restrictions.

The Turramurra retail store located at 1315 Pacific Highway Turramurra is open Monday to Friday from 9am – 5pm and Saturday 9am to 12 noon and will be closed from 22 December.

Cowan & Lewis are very mindful of the inconvenience this may cause with restricted accessibility whilst avoiding unnecessary queuing and delays to ensure the safety of our Staff, Parents and students.


