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RELIGION

Students are introduced to the stories of Jesus and will learn about Jesus', life, his friends and how to be a disciple of Jesus.



ENGLISH

Year 1 will speak, listen, read and write every day. Their writing focus will be narrative, information report, response and discussion texts. Students will work independently or cooperatively during reading group sessions, whilst the teacher is instructing a focus group/quided reading. Explicit teaching of spelling strategies will occur daily using the whole school approach of Sound Waves.

MATHS

Year I will be focusing on the topics of: Fractions and Decimals, Chance, Mass, Money and Volume and Capacity. Explicit teaching of specific concepts is taught with students both working independently and cooperatively, with teacher guided focus groups.

GEOGRAPHY

We will continue our unit Features of Places from last term. Students will begin to investigate the weather and seasons and will identify different patterns of weather in Australia. Students will also identify ways people interact with and care for different places around them.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Changes in the Sky

This unit provides opportunities for students to explore natural, made and managed features that undergo change, in relation to the clouds and sun.









PDH

In this unit of work students will identify the qualities and strength required to develop resilience and determination through exploring a range of stories about individuals and groups who have overcome challenges.

VISUAL ARTS

Students discover how artists represent the places where they live and work, as well as the objects around them. Students make drawings, collages, prints and paintings representing different objects "Up in the air". Students will be participating in a weekly Music/Dance/Drama lesson on Thursday.

PE

1Blue will participate in a PE lesson with Mrs Catto on Tuesday and 1Green on Wednesday. Extra Sport with the Year 1 class teachers will take place on Fridays.
