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## RELIGION

## HSIE –Geography

- This term we are continuing with the second inquiry of the unit 'Bushfire Mitigation', which focusses on developing a bushfire survival plan.
- We will examine the results of the Royal Commission into Natural Disaster Arrangements that was presented in 2020.

## SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY.

Stage 3 of the **Digital Technologies** strand focuses on understanding the role individual components of digital systems play in processing and representing data. Students define problems, and design, modify and follow simple algorithms when designing solutions that involve branching and iteration.



## PDHPE

**Safe Me, Safe You** – Students will explore a range of scenarios and identify factors that assist them to recognise if they need to act in order to protect their own or other's safety. They will research and identify people, places and sources of information that can be trusted when they and others need support or assistance.

## VISUAL ARTS

### Creative Sustainability

- Students will examine how art conventions can be used to convey messages around the subject matter of sustainability and develop art making techniques using sustainable materials including pencil shaving artworks.
